By luck, the chip just fits across the width of the compact pedal and for months the design time worked to squeeze the rest of the components on to the printed circuit board. The design is utilizing a 12 bit AD converter producing a flat frequency response between 40Hz and 7kHz. The DD2 did officially go out of sale 1986 but it was relaunched without changes as the DD3 and has continued its life through till today. The black control plate had cream coloured text early on. The text colour was changed to silver somewhere around serial number 480000 late 1984. The first blue label used did not have the FCC compliance text usually found on all digital pedals. This was changed very quickly so this blue label is rare. This popular pedal had controls for delay time, effect level and mode, making it easy to add everything from a short slapback to longer, tempobased delays. This one is from 83ish. 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UTILIZATION Fairly easy pedal in that it only has hour knobs and one foot pedal. Takes a 9v battery of plug. It has delay times that goes from 12 mil to 800 which is probably most that people are going to use. You can take the D time up to around 200 on long delay times and the notes follow a dotted 8th note delay. Great for ambient sounds or U2 times delays. The overall pedal has a very clear transparent warm tone that compliments your guitar playing. It sounds great in the mix and allows the user to add subtle delay repeats for slap back tones or long delay times for solos and such. There is much to explore with this pedal if you have the time. SOUND QUALITY The tone from it is fantastic for all delay applications. It is versatile when you need long or short delay times. I like using it with a Strat into any amp. Preferably a Marshall amp with some heavy gain. I like using it to tailor my guitar tone a bit and sometimes to use as a cutting repeater. Very easy to dial in Welcome to the Jungle tones with this pedal. My favorite setting is a long delay time with the D time up around 200 for some Edge type tones. Since this is a digital delay and cuts a little more than an analog echo. I prefer to use this when needing delays to cut in the mix with the band. I have two beefs with this pedal. one being that it isnt true bypas so it will change your tone when you are not using it. You can get it modified to become true bypass but it would be nice to have that come standard. The next thing is if it only had a tamp tempo feature on it somewhere it would be killer. I like using rhythmic delay times so having that ability would make this pedal amazing. OVERALL OPINION I like that it will last you almost forever since Boss makes things to last. You wont have any problems with it failing in the middle of a gig somewhere. I also like how it is small and compact like most Boss pedals are so they fit nicely on your pedal board.

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The next thing is that is has a sweet delay tone that is warm and smooth. It floats over your guitar playing very sweetly where as an analog delay adds more character to the tone it self. I would recommend this pedal to anyone who needs a simple digital delay pedal and doesnt want to break the bank to buy one. They dont make this unit any more and have marketed the DD3 which is basically the same pedal with some different guts inside. Other than that I dont really know the difference. The settings are arguably the most minimal settings on any Boss Digital Delay, simply being able to adjust level, delay time, feedback, etc. There are two outputs, one on either side, but i havent ever used more than one so I cant comment on using that. Theres nothing crazy like midi or computer editing options on it either. UTILIZATION This product is incredibly simple. If you dont want to much getting in the way, this would be perfect for you. Not much too explain and will only

take a few moments to get a grasp of it. Even if you don't know what any of the knob settings mean at first, you'll get a feel for it quickly. SOUND QUALITY Boss makes great digital delay pedals, and this one is no exception. I've never had anything but good experiences with this pedal as far as sound quality goes. I play guitar and I think the pedal is perfect for this, though I doubt a bass would sound any worse going through it. The hold feature is pretty cool although it's not a replacement for a loop station, since it tends to sound pretty clipped. It's better as a jarring effect than a legitimate loop. OVERALL OPINION I've used this pedal for about 5 years and I've never had a problem with it really. I sometimes wish that I could do a bit more with it, but that would mean getting something much more expensive and generally unnecessary for me personally. I like how simple it is, which makes it easy to change settings on the go.

That being said, programming preset settings onto it is not possible, and that would likely make it easier to use in live settings. Frankly, this pedal in Japan is a good deal and I can only advise especially for the registry so Satriani Lead. UTILIZATION Publishing of sound effects or is it easy. The lack of heat DD3 and DD5 is too expensive for what it is. A clean from time to time then. UTILIZATION Configuration rather simple, yet comprehensive enough. Simply select the mode type of delay from the shortest to longest and adjust to convenience the number of repetitions and duration of effect. As a result, the possibilities are quite numerous. The manual in English, if not indispensable, allowing the novice to avoid mix brushes between the functions of each of the knobs. For cons, the main drawback is the fact that it is imperative to connect with an adapter boss at 30 euros really an unfortunate trade policy is theft!, Failing to get a terrible hum with any other transformer. As for batteries, not really cost effective because the machine has been rather greedy. SOUND QUALITY The different modes are effective and really distinct palette of sound is fuller. I use it at the end of the chain effects loop of my classic 30 with a LP Standard and a strat us. Combined with delays of my DOD pedals, it produces interesting effects. I mainly use the following settings level at 13h, 15h to feedback, delay time at 9am, all with 800ms mode. The effect is rather flat and allows some of the best psychedelic delirium effect. I used a lot with a bottleneck in the way of David Gilmour, to draw atmospheric melodies, songs like dolphins or mermaids, or when combined with a distortion always with the bottleneck to draw sound apocalyptic. However, I find the sound a bit cold and synthetic this will appear more or less depending on the settings, especially compared to my Ibanez AD9.

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Combined with other delays, we can draw really interesting stuff; she has no other major flaw, if not the fact that it takes a boss to power transformer, on pain of seeing your cock up her a roar worthy of an engine Airbus A 320. Once purchased the said transformer, no problem, so the default is zero if not having slammed 30 euros more for a simple transformer and into the pockets of Roland!. value for money is worth OCCAZ I bought 80 euros at the time, especially considering the prices of his little sisters DD3, DD5, DD6, sounds, it seems, much more cold with unnecessary functions. 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Ive been using the loop function a boat load, been layering riffs on top of eachother to make a big sounding metal riff. And I really like the modulation effect, if you turn the delay time right down it makes a decent chorus effect, Ive been using this a little more than the regular delay to get a more ambient sound. Id defy recommend this pedal if you have the money.Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again It takes some getting usedto as the selector knob is a bit fiddly. Works with both on my electric and acoustic guitars. Provides some real depth to the sound and as it has a stereo output can be connected by two cables to a stereo amp or two separate amps. I have briefly experimented with both options and got reasonable results so far. I need more time to experiment with the settings to see how well this aspect works. A good buy.
