Excellent everyday watch in most respects. The Bad Despite the picture, it is very difficult to see the hands even in low light, let alone no light. There just isnt enough contrast. Yes, you can hit the light to read the time in the digital display, but I want something I can glance at and tell the time. This brings us to the first problem. Yes, it lights up in low or no light conditions. The problem is it needs light to charge up the particles in the gas to make it glow. That means that it will glow for a pretty short period of time. Plan on seeing it glow even ten minutes after the lights are out, and youre out of luck. Even with my lamp on in the other corner of the room, it isnt enough light to keep them lit up. Ill have to do some research into another model that has better features in that respect.

If anyone has any ideas, please let me know. I really wanted to give this more stars, but given that it performs so poorly in low or zero light, I just cant do it. Its a great watch and Ill definitely use it when Im out and about, but even in a poorly lit room, you can barely see the hands on this thing, which is disappointing. People that are used to the typical G features should be aware of this. There is no countdown timer or auto EL when tilted towards you and you can only have one dual time zone too. This is an aside but the LCD is a negative display which has its cons. Its great in the day, but you have to use the light button at night when analog reading isnt an option. Im not going to subtract stars because there was a picture and I didnt notice the display was hard to see at night. Perfect indestructible analog other than those small issues. I wanted a watch to replace my Rolex so some thug didnt chop my arm off to get it. This watch looked great, but resetting the time requires standing on one foot while rubbing your belly, holding down three obscure buttons and you get the point too much overhead. Have decided since its insured, Ill quickly take the Rolex off and hand it to the crook. It is also a great size, not small, not too large. So many watches these days seem way too big, especially for those of use that dont have gorilla wrists. The opening is way too high for the band thickness so it tends to keep sliding away leaving the end of the band to flap around and catch on things. The opening height should be around 5mm and it is probably 8mm/10mm I dont have it with me to measure. The digital display is hard to see especially for those of us with older eyes. It is also blocked by the hands between the 4 and 8 positions, but I guess that should be obvious by the design. It has been a while, but I remember setting the correct time seemed tedious. Certainly not as easy as it is on some other watches I have.

Overall I really like the watch and would recommend it especially for the price just make sure you get the smaller replacement band loops. I have multiple G Shocks and know how good they are. I wear a couple to work and they are tuff. But this watch I was disappointed at how you set the analog time. You literally hold the button down as it slowly spins to the right time. But dont accidentally pass the time. Not convenient at all when it comes to time change. And in all honesty, I expected better. And probably will just get my friend a better one. Good watch for a kid though. The reviews

were all good so I wanted to try it. It may be a lower end Gshock but it is the only one I have had. The price on Amazon was wonderful. I see it priced at least 20% higher on other sites. It is the best fitting watch I have ever placed upon my wrist. It feels good and sits just the way I like it. The dial can be a bit dark depending on the lighting of the room. I knew it did not have a second hand so I can't factor that into this review. I have only had it for about 10 days now so my judgement is not final. I am no whiz but setting the time etc. was simple. If I can do it easily, anyone can. At under 50 this was my choice. Overall I am so happy with, that I now wear it nearly all the time as a casual watch and not just for bike riding. Very strong especially bracelet, which is a fault of many competitors and the choice of analog hand watch and light up digital watch are probably the two main features I use most. I suspect my use of the stopwatch and alarm will be very limited so cannot comment. Main personal tip is wear very loose on your wrist and you will hardly notice too tight and the strap is tight on movement more than many comparable watches I found. Chose black as the most practical colour and no regrets and face is easily readable in most lights. If the battery really does last ten years claimed then I will be a very happy buyer! Please try again The light only lights up the small digital display so when you wake up at night and want to know the time you can hardly read it but even worse if you like me like the digital display to show the day and date instead of just repeating the time you won't even be able to see the time and won't be able to navigate back to it as it is so fiddly. Even if you have the time selected and you can read the tiny digits the hour hand is likely to be right over it and you can't see it anyway. How on earth did they not see this as a major issue. Secondly the analogue watch and digital display are not connected so you have to try to sync the two yourselves. What a load a rubbish. Even cheap combination watches can sync with each other. Such a shame, lovely looking watch but absolutely hopeless in use. Returned to Amazon. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again I bought a DW 6800 and I got abused for years and then the bezel split and I could not get a replacement. Still got it in naked form although it looks stupid. Then a DW 6900, the plastic housing split on that near the strap so that was rendered useless. Then a DW7900 which I only wore at weekends and have a GD100 as a beater which I recommend for just that at 49. Anyway this watch is great for what it is. Yes the reverse lcd is small to read and the watch hands get in the way. The backlight is wimpy and you have to set both the analogue hands and digital time separately. This doesn't bother me as I only use the lower display for month, date and day. My phone is my alarm and I don't need a different time zone or stop watch. All I wanted was a G shock with analogue hands that I can wear at the weekends with whatever I chose to wear. Get it wet no problem and the battery will last because it will only get used twice a year when the clocks go forward and back.

You have to hold the top left button down for analogue adjustment and the time at the bottom on mine in the digital part is wrong, but as I said, it isn't very legible and isn't a problem. There are lots of G shocks available. I recommend this for analogue hands and the GD100 which is cheaper, but man it takes a beating. The straps on the GD100 crack where the retaining buckle sits over time, but the battery lasts forever. Not sure how long the battery will last on this, but as it will be used little, probably double the manufacturer period of three years. All in all you can't go wrong with a G Shock. Just make a list of what you want it to do and always read the reviews. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again The last one lasted 11 years and I only needed to replace it as the plastic surround has started to disintegrate. A solid, basic watch that is bomb proof, I thoroughly recommend. Please try again The dial isn't as bright and legible especially the red hour hand and the rear end of the minute hand sticks out a bit far so if you haven't got good lighting and good eyesight it's not all as clear as it should be. The small digital display is a reverse image and often hard to see. The light only lights the digital display and not the dial at all, it would have helped it to do so. Setting the time is a nightmare, holding a tricky button in while the dial slowly moves round in forward only, so make a mistake and go past and you can't go back, gotta go around again I think twice, I'm now half a day out with regards to the calendar date changing, not

sure if I can change it on the date or if gotta do the dial crap again, will look at another time . Its such a shame, this watch should simply be better than it is. It just misses the mark on a few important points. Want to love this watch but finding it hard to even like. Sorry, we failed to record your vote.

Please try again I need a reliable robust watch and after reading all the excellent reviews I went with this G Shock. It was easy enough to setup but the major problem is the hands of the watch are in the way of the digital display. It is a major design fault. Also the display is extremely hard to read unless illuminated but you can't do any adjustments in low light, and in the dark you can't even use the stop watch properly as you can't select it and have it illuminated at the same time to start and stop it. I can't believe this watch has so many problems yet the reviews are so good. For a Casio watch it's not up to scratch as far as I'm concerned. Really silly things that should have been addressed in the design phase and product testing. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again However, in my opinion this model is far too complicated and difficult to synchronise the analog and digital display. Also, on this watch at least the fingers are difficult to read. As a result I cannot recommend this particular watch but the supplier provided a good service. I gave this watch to a colleague but noticed after a few days, he was not wearing it. Your average junky quartz watch will most likely have a poor movement inside Sekonda etc but I suspect that the movement in this watch is relatively good quality even at this level. I daresay their high end models have very high quality components but I have no quibbles with what Ive seen in this model after nine years. Casios production facility is like a space age lab and I suspect everything is made in house including the aforementioned movements so I have alot of faith in them as a brand.

However, to be totally honest their not really to my tastes anymore but I dont think you can go with wrong one as a take it anywhere and do anything watch. My only quibble is with the time setting function in that you have to hold a button down to advance the hands very slowly in only a clockwise direction so summertime adjustment is a tad painful but oh well. hardly a huge problem. On a side note I stealthed mine by removing all the printed text off the case and it looks great like a bare bones military type watch. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again For this price is a very good buy. Its a very light on the wrist, and the controls are straightforward. So far I experienced only a little glitch with the calendar after I adjusted the time on holiday and the date started changing several hours before midnight. Had to go to a shop to have it fixed as the manual is very basic on info. Other than that, its a great watch! Sorry, we failed to record your vote. The only problem I have and its nothing to do with this particular watch, is to do with dual display watches in general. Every well, most time you need to look at the date or use the stopwatch etc. The hands are handy for a quick glance at the time, but its a nuisance when you need the display and the hands are covering the digital panel. Please try again Dial is very legible and looks kind of classy almost. Biggest downside is the reverse lcd useless in anything but bright daylight, almost unusable indoors.

I really dont know why Casio did this. If this had a positive lcd, it would be faultless. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again The face and hands are clear and easy to read, as is the digital display when the hands arent in the way. The LCD screen can show local time or date, with a dual

time setting I think would be really useful on holiday or away travelling. It also has an alarm and stopwatch function and a backlight for the LCD, all of which are very intuitive to use. On to the niggles. Whilst I really like this watch, a few minor factors mean I can't give it 5 stars. The first being the strap. There are deep ridges in the strap near where it attaches to the main body of the watch. I find these rub against the bony part of my wrist, and I have to adjust where it sits quite often to keep it from getting uncomfortable. It also has no crown to set the hands, only a button to move them forward, which is set flush to the casing to avoid accidental adjustment. The problem is that holding this button down is quite painful on the fingertip, especially if you overshoot the current time and have to go all the way through 12 full rotations of the hands to get it right. Very good watch considering I got it for 55. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again. It's simple to use, easy to set up, yes I have to agree with many of the reviews I have read before I purchased, that the back light isn't on for long and that it is almost impossible to see the analogue time when in the dark but that's why there's a back light on the digital clock. The strap is comfy, wide and feels good on my wrist. Apart from not wanting to take it off since it arrived, it's a great watch, you just can't get any better.
