A ficus usually runs \$20 to \$60, depending on the seller and initial size. The outdoor air conditioning provided by the trees reduces the energy used within your home or office. The shade provided by deciduous trees strategically planted cools buildings during the warm months, allows the sun rays to flow through its branches in winter and protects buildings from cold winds. With some planning, urban trees can help minimize the island’s impact of heat on many cities. The islands of heat are cities that are often different degrees warmer than the periphery because urban areas generate and trap heat. Studies in Atlanta found that temperatures in the center were 5-8 degrees warmer than those in the suburbs. This, in turn, increased the number of local storms [source: NASA]. Phoenix is also warmer than its peripheral areas. In 1950, Phoenix was 6 degrees warmer than the nearby Casa Grande Monument. In 2007, however, the temperature difference rose to 14 degrees [source: Christian Science Monitor]. When trees grow in urban areas, surface and weather temperatures are lower. Researchers found that planting a tree west and one south of a house can significantly reduce energy consumption. According to the Environmental Protection Agency study, annual cooling costs were reduced from 8 to 18%, while annual heating costs were reduced from 2 to 8% [source: EPA]. The leaves also filter particles from the air, including dust, ozone, carbon monoxide and other atmospheric pollutants. Through the process of photosynthesis, the trees remove carbon dioxide (a greenhouse gas) and release oxygen in the air. Trees store carbon dioxide, called carbon sequestration, and – depending on the size of the tree -- can contain 35 to 800 pounds of carbon dioxide every year [source: EPA]. The trees are not our saviors from the smog, though. Photochemical smog is the smog caused when sunlight and chemical compounds such as car exhaust combine. Moreover, planting trees as a global warming solution – a practice commonly linked to carbon compensation – can have a positive impact on global temperature control only if planted in the tropics, a thin geographic band around the equator. Normally the trees help cool the planet by absorbing carbon dioxide as part of the photosynthesis process and evaporating water in the air. In the tropics, the water naturally evaporates from the trees, increasing the cloudy cover and maintaining the coldest temperatures. Otherof the tropics, however, the researchers are discovering that the forests trap heat because their dense and dark buds absorb sunlight.
