Conflicts are the backbone of the narrative. As Kurt Vonnegut once said, "every story is about a character who gets in trouble and then tries to get out." Without something to rub, a story is not a story, it's just a series of events without stakes. As a literary concept, you could express the conflict with a simple formula: (CHARACTER + WANT) X. The protagonist of a story always wants something, but something else prevents him from getting it. This interaction between the character, his desires and his obstacles is what guides every story. If this central conflict is boring or insensitive, the plot will be boring and confusing. But if the conflict is compelling, logical and emotionally impactful, readers will be desperate to know how everything develops. In this short series of articles, we will further immerse ourselves in this formula and reveal the most common types of conflict in literature. And if you're a writer, we'll also show you a simple way to identify the real conflict that is at the heart of every story you're writing. But first, let's look at the two great categories in which all kinds of literary conflict belong. What they want. This kind of conflict is usually interpersonal or social. Ned Stark (Game of Thrones, HBO) Example: Robinson Crusoe ' At a subtler level, in Robinson Crusoe by Daniel Defoe, the hero of the same name confronts a conflict of survival when he is shipwrecked on a deserted island. Exposed to the fictitious nature of Mother Earth, she wants to survive and leave the island, but must learn to the weather storms and unknown threats if there is a hope of rescue. Example: She is the man Nel In the film She's the Man, Viola wants nothing but to play football. But when the girl's team in her high school is cut and they won't let her try for the boy's team, claiming that girls can't play football as well as boys, she impersonates her twin brother and tries out for the boy's team at their rival school to prove that everyone is wrong. Internal conflict The internal conflict is the struggle between emotions, values or desires within a character that prevents them from reaching their desired goal. These conflicts can result from any combination of the expectations, desires, duties and fears of the character. And even if they can arise because of external conditions in which the character needs to make a choice, they are ultimately not on those external forces, but on the battle that goes inside the heart and mind of a character. Making Universal Specific Stories An inner strife is often morally complex or universal, and this is what will ultimately resonate with your readers. It is also often a central part of establishing a character arc. Example: The Hunger Games ' In Suzanne Collins's The Hunger Games, Katniss is torn between his reluctance to kill another human being and his need to survive in the arena. Katniss Everdeen (The Hunger Games, Lionsgate) Example: The Padrino . In Mario Puzo's Padrino, Michael Corleone wants to stay out of the family business, but cannot resist the extraction of the filial obligation. Examples of internal conflict in literary internal conflict – also called Man vs. Self - is a battle within a character. In movies or TV shows, this could be shown as the good angel on one shoulder and the evil demon on the other. With internal conflicts, you might feel a clash between competing desires. For example, an alcoholic may struggle to not The bottle of Bourbon. That person knows he needs to stop drinking, but the desire to drink is very strong, leading to an intensefight. In fact, there are different types of internal conflict, including: Conflicts on religion come into play when a person begins to question their faith or their culture. For example, someone might question God after the death of a loved one. Sexual conflicts are a war between your moral and sexual desires. For example, a person may feel conflicted to have sex before marriage. Moral conflict is where you could bend your morale for a perceived greater good or immediate need. For example, a person could steal food to feed their hungry family. Conflict in self-image occurs when a person's actions do not align with how they look. For example, a mother can feel guilty if she thinks she's patient, but she loses her character with her children. Love conflicts is when you hurt something you love. Spanking children is a great example of this type of internal conflict. existential conflicts are internal struggles that a character might have on the meaning of life or on the meaning of their lives. For example, an environmentalist could work to save the planet while secretly believing that it is condemned. Intpersonal or social conflicts are internal conflicts between your personal feelings and social norms or expectations. A naturally introverted person pretending to be extroverted to fit classmates is an example. This can make them feel guilty of not being true for themselves. The internal conflict is a character element that is used to add depth, mood, morality and humanism to characters both in movies and in books. Books and movies are a great place to find examples of internal struggles. While the character struggles with their inner thoughts and feelings, you begin to see their growth and change. Explore some famous examples that truly exemplify man against self-confidence. Fight Club, a book by Chuck Palahniuk that has been adapted into a film, is a great example of internal conflict. The narrator struggles with worldly life so heavily that it creates an alter ego in Tyler Durden. This comes to a head at the end of the story when you realize that both characters are the same person. An area that exemplified the inner struggle of the narrator is in the line: Perhaps self-improvement is not the answer. Tyler didn't know his father. Maybe self-destruction is the answer. In this passage, the narrator is having an existential internal struggle. He is trying to understand the meaning of all this and how an unwanted person could enter a perfect society. The narrator concludes that since perfect is not the answer, possibly self-destruction is. In Shakespeare's Hamlet, there are several moral internal conflicts. Not only Hamlet struggle with wanting to kill Claudio in revenge,also struggles internally with one's depression and thoughts of suicide. Act 3, Scene 1 demonstrates Hamlet's struggle with suicidal thoughts: To be, or not to be - this is the question: Let it be nobler in the mind to suffer Sleds and arrows of scandalous fortune O a a arms against a sea of problems And with the opposite their end. Dying, sleeping... Besides, Hamlet's need for revenge is strong. His father's ghost is calling him, too. But... Hamlet knows it's not right to kill Claudius for revenge. This inner moral conflict plunges him into deep depression and apparent madness. This, in turn, creates an even deeper inner conflict in Hamlet than whether it is better to live in pain or to die and end suffering. In Lois Lowry's The Giver, Jonas' internal struggle is built as she gains the various memories her company has lost from the donor. This is seen in chapter 13: They were content with their life which had none of the vibrations which its own was assuming. And he was angry with himself, that he couldn't change that for them. His inner struggle becomes a moral inner conflict when he discovers that Gabriel will be killed. So you have to choose whether you want to save him and leave or stay and let him die. He finally decides to go save Gabriel. In The Sixth Sense, Cole Sear shows inner struggles as he approaches his sixth sense. He exhibits internal interpersonal conflicts because he wants to conform to social norms, but this is impossible. Cole also has mixed feelings for helping ghosts and wanting to ignore them, which leads to an inner moral conflict. While internal conflict can take on an important role in literature, it usually happens in conjunction with external conflict. As the name suggests, there are external conflicts between a character and an external or external force. This could be another character, such as the conflict between Claudius and Hamlet, or even a force of nature, such as the way the snow hits Jonas and Gabriel. External fights take place in the outside world, unlike internal fights that take place inside a character's head. Good characters are well rounded and based on defining traits like having strong values. Because of these traits, they experience different kinds of inner struggle as they navigate their fictitious worlds.
